Now, it looks as though we have at least 7-10 days of temps well above the usual for this time of the year, while our northern states are experiencing a snow and ice blizzard from coast to coast! Are our early migrating birds having the same questions?? Are they thinking, "Should we stay or should we go"?? Stay tuned!!
