Field Trips-Larry Morgan

Here's a summary of field trips since our last meeting. You're always welcome to join our activities

March 4 Sparrow Trip

This field trip was held in the MS Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station (MAFES) south of McNeil, MS. There were 5 PWAS members, 2 Mississippi Coast Audubon Society members, and our guide (Reggie Davis) and his daughter. We observed 31 species with the highlights being 2 Barn Owls and 2 White-crowned Sparrows.

April 22 Dauphin Island Spring Migration Trip

A total of 8 PWAS members participated (Grayson Rayborn, Jane Rayborn, Diane Lafferty, Kathy Edwards, Logan Firmin, Theresa O'Neal, Mike Morgan, and Larry Morgan). We were able to list 97 species for the day. My personal highlights were a Veery and an American Bittern at the DI airport. It was a great birding day considering the high winds. It's always good to spend some Island time!

2022-2023 Yard Count

The Chapter bragging rights contest (species seen in your yard) is in the final stretch. Bring your list of birds to the May meeting. The winner will be recognized and will receive bragging rights for the summer (or until a new counting period is declared and finished).

Summer Butterfly Counts
